Step 1

Divide your team into 3 Roles: **Trend Selector** / **Google Slides Scribe** / **Process Guru** Note that all participants will participate in the conversation. **The Process Guru**'s job is to keep time and follow the instructions below.

Step 2

Trend Selector: Share your screen as you navigate to the Trend Card page on the FutureVersary Site.

Read a few of the trend cards aloud to the group. There are eight in total. Ultimately you want to select two trends that you want to plot on the coordinate grid.

Google Slides Scribe: Share your screen as you as you place one of the selected trends on the horizontal axis and one on the vertical. Note that each trend has a + and -. Plot for the extreme version of the trend on the positive side. The negative is for the milder version of the trend. You now have four future scenarios.

Step 3

Whole Group:

Talk through the four scenarios and compare them to our present world. Are people thriving? Does our current reality collapse, or is it transformed?

Give each scenario a title. You can use the titles available in the Scenario Title Bank or compose your own. You should end up with four scenario titles in all.

Step 4

Whole Group:

Out of the four available, pick one scenario you'd like to explore further—it might be the most radical one, or the one you think is most likely—and describe it in the scenario description box. Aim for 2 or 3 sentences. You can use the sentences starters to prompt your thinking.

Step 5

Google Slides Scribe:

Copy your scenario description, move onto the next slide and paste it into the appropriate box. Read your scenario description and, as a team, discuss and answer the following questions: Who might benefit the most in your scenario

Who might be poorly-served? What injustices might emerge?

What does this scenario suggest about our lives right now?
